



## **Visitors Centre Mont Terri (CCV) – St-Ursanne**

### **Information for visitors regarding the Covid-19**

- From 13 September 2021, the Covid certificate is compulsory for those over 16 years of age. It will be requested and checked by CCV staff at the entrance to the Visitor Centre at the beginning of each visit.

The valid Covid certificate concerns the following 3 cases:

- Covid certificate: vaccinated person
  - Covid certificate: person tested negative
  - Covid certificate: cured person
- The Mont Terri Visitors Centre makes disinfection means available in order to respect the hygiene measures. The person responsible for the group, the guides and the security person of the CCV take care that the hygiene measures are kept during the visit.
  - According to the Canton of Jura regulations, the maximum number of visitors allowed for a visit is 50 (guide and security person included). After consultation with the visit coordinator, visits for bigger groups are possible. The group has to be divided in smaller groups, or if the visits are planned at different times.
  - Masks must be worn during the minibus transfer only.
  - The CCV will provide masks free of charge to each visitor in case they do not have one.
  - The person responsible for the group makes sure that the group members are informed of the hygiene and security measures before the visit. At the beginning of the visit, the person responsible for the group must check that the list of attendance is correct and complete.
